Dear Parents and Carers,

CHILL and AIR QUALITY STUDY (Children's Health in London)

At St Mary and St Pancras CE School, we are committed to promoting the good health of all members of our community. Being able to breathe clean air is very important to the development of children's lungs. The air in London can be very polluted especially near our school. Researchers from CHILL (Children's Health in London and Luton) have recruited Year 2, 3 and 4 children from schools in Central London and Luton to participate in a study into how pollution affects children's lungs.

This is the CHILL study. Researchers from Queen Mary University would like to carry out a simple test to check your child's lungs and general health once a year for up to four years. This will provide you with useful information about your child's health and development.

A member of staff will be present during the test and your child may opt out at any time.

The children are having an assembly on Friday to learn about the study and what they need to do to take part. The study happens in school time.

We would like to invite you to a brief parents meeting to learn how you and your child can take part.
