STMP Remote Learning Offer 5th-15th January 2021.

Dear Parents and Carers,

Learning is now moving on-line for the vast majority of our pupils. Last year, we posted lesson slides on the school website but we are now embarking on using **Google Classrooms**. The benefits of using this platform include teachers being able to record teaching sessions, set a variety of activities as well as give feedback on your child's work. We hope that this is a better way to teach remotely and will welcome your feedback once we are up and running.

Google Classrooms

Today, the teachers have had training in how to set up and use on-line learning on Google Classrooms. This is new learning for teachers and they need time to apply their training from today in order to set up learning on their Google Classrooms page- therefore the learning on Google Classrooms will begin on **Wednesday 6th January**.

There will be three lessons a day for Y1-Y6 and a slightly different offer for Nursery and Reception, due to the age of the children. This week, as teachers gain confidence, the maths lesson will be a recorded session and the other two lessons will be delivered as slides. Next week both the maths and literacy lessons will be recorded teaching sessions.

Tomorrow, an email will go out telling you how to access Google Classroom on Wednesday. Keep an eye on your email please.
