




## St Mary & St Pancras C. E. Primary School

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you had a lovely summer break-It was wonderful to welcome you and your children all back to school this morning and all through the same gate at last!

### School Maintenance

Over the summer break, we have had a new LED lighting system installed throughout the classrooms, as well as site-maintenance and gardening work.

### Dinner Money

A school meal costs £2.29 per day, £11.45 per week. Please pay at the office or send the money into school with your child in a clearly labelled envelope every Monday for the week ahead.

### Packed Lunches

Please ensure your child brings their packed lunch to school with them in the morning. They should not be delivered to the office after school has started.

### Breakfast Club

School opens at 8am for free Breakfast Club. Children must arrive between 8am to 8.15 sharp, through the front doors. Children who arrive after 8:15 will not be allowed into the hall and will not get breakfast, so please make sure your child is on time if you want them to attend.

### Punctuality

The main school gates open from 8:45 to 9am. They close at 9am promptly.

Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children start at 8:45am.

Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 start at 8:50am.

All children must come to school through the gate on time.

All children will be dismissed from the playground now.

From Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> September, and every Tuesday afterwards, parents who want to can come into their children's classroom from 8:45/50 to 9:15am.

### School Uniform

All children in our school are required to wear full school uniform, including **black school shoes**. We do not allow trainers, oversized jo-jo bows or jewellery, apart from that outlined in our school uniform policy.

All children are required to take part in **PE and swimming**. Physical fitness is critical in our digital age and learning to swim is a life-saving skill. All children are expected to bring the appropriate kit in with them on the morning of their lesson. Children who have PE in the mornings can wear their kit to school but must have school uniform and shoes to change into afterwards.

Teachers will make swimming and PE days clear in their letters to you this Friday. Children who forget their kit or do not wear full uniform will receive a letter to bring to you as a reminder. It is good for children to learn to take responsibility for their learning resources so please help them do so. The same goes for **musical instruments**.

Finally, we look forward to welcoming you all to your **meet the teacher meetings at 3:45pm on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> September**, in your child's classroom.

Wed are keen to restart the PTFA with any keen parents who wish to work as a group to organise fundraising events for the school, such as the Christmas and Summer Fairs. I will write to you soon with a date for an initial meeting.
